## French Grammar Express: Possessive Pronouns

Reminder: a pronoun <u>replaces</u> a word, often to prevent repetition.

Possessive adjectives<br/>in English are:To prevent repetition, we<br/>would say:This skirtThis oneThese coatsThese (ones)That dressThat oneThose socksThose (ones)

## French demonstrative pronouns

\*Reminder  $\rightarrow$  a = un, une, des (some)  $\rightarrow$  the = le, la, les, l'

-ci  $\rightarrow$  here, closer  $-la \rightarrow$  there, further
