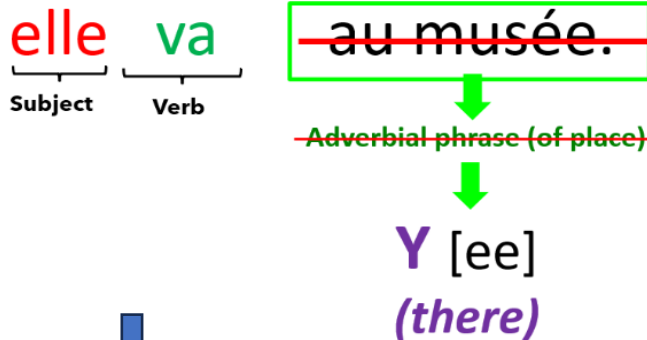

The pronoun Y [ee]



REMINDER: Pronouns

- Pronouns **REPLACE** nouns/words
- **Position:**
 - before the conjugated verb
 - before the infinitive
 - before the auxiliary

elle va Y

Position of the adverb

Before the **conjugated** verb → Elle Y va. – *she goes there.*

Before the **infinitive** verb → Elle veut Y aller. – *She wants to go there.*

Before the **auxiliary** verb → Elle Y est allée. – *she went there.*

The pronoun en [ã]

What does it replace? → A noun affected by the idea of quantity.

In a nutshell

You use **en** to prevent repeating a noun preceded by:

- un
- une
- de
- du
- de la
- des
- de l'
- a number



→ Tu en veux? *Do you want some?*

→ Tu en as bu. *You drank (some).*

→ J'en ai. *I have (some).*

→ J'en voudrais trois. *I would like three (of them).*

→ Il en achète un kilo. *he buys one kilo (of them)*

→ Je n'en mange pas. *I don't eat any.*

→ Il veut en faire. *He wants to do (some).*
