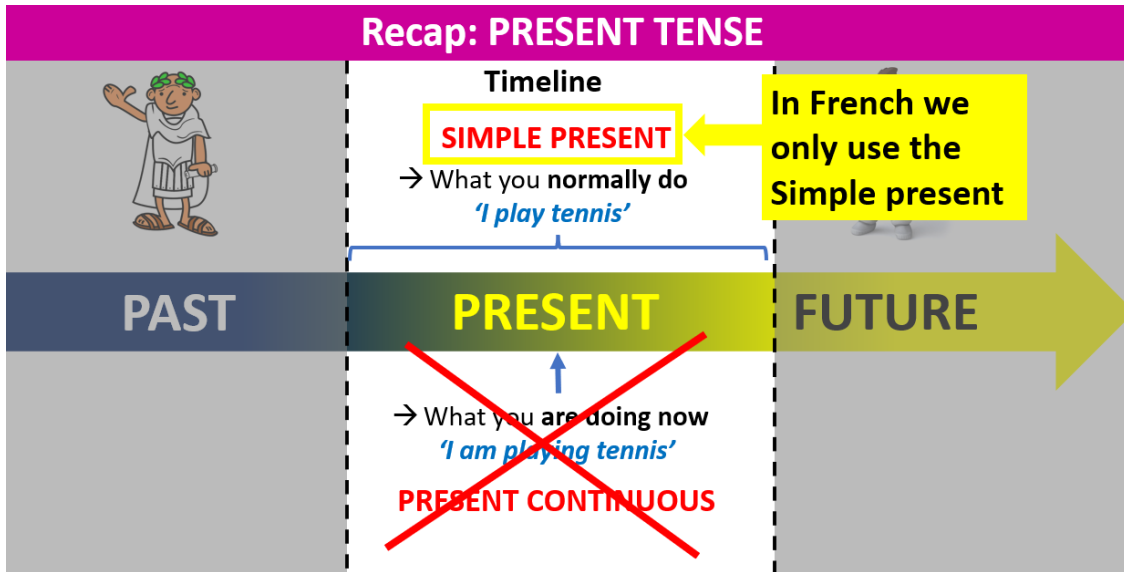


Intermediate Course- Lesson 5 summary



AN INFINITIVE VERB IS....

...a verb is that is **NOT CONJUGATED**

- ➡ We don't know who does the action.
- ➡ We don't know when the action takes place

to choose, to finish, to grow ...

2. Knock off the –RE
3. Add the correct PRESENT TENSE ending:

1st person	je	-s	<i>silent</i>	nous	-ons	[ö]
2nd person	tu	-s	<i>silent</i>	vous	-ez	[☺]
3rd Person	il/elle/on		<i>nothing</i>	ils/elles	-ent	<i>Silent but previous letter pronounced</i>
